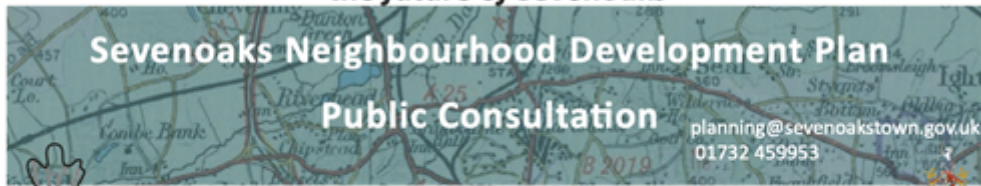

### When you contact us

### Information Security

Sevenoaks Town Council has a duty to ensure the security of personal data.
